CALL FOR PAPERS

Uzbekistan International Islamic Academy in cooperation with the Research Centre for Islamic History, Art and Culture (IRCICA) are organizing the Third International Scientific-Practical Conference on the theme “Islamic Civilization in Central Asia: Past and Present”, to be held on 17 October 2022 at the International Islamic Academy of Uzbekistan, Tashkent. The first two conferences on this theme were held in 2020 and 2021.

Scholars and researchers wishing to participate in the conference can submit scientific papers and abstracts in Uzbek, Russian, and English languages by 3 October 2022.

PAPERS AND ABSTRACTS ARE ACCEPTED IN THE FOLLOWING SUBJECT AREAS:

1. Islamic culture and arts in the Central Asian region.
2. Scientific and spiritual heritage of Central Asian thinkers.
3. Epigraphy and architecture of historical monuments of Central Asia.
4. Commonality and uniqueness in the customs and traditions of the peoples of Central Asia.

INFORMATION FOR THE AUTHORS

Formal requirements for the texts of the papers:

- Text size - at least 3 to 5 pages on A-4 size paper, letter size - 14 kegel, line spacing at 1.5 intervals, 2 cm from the top and bottom, 3 cm from the left, 1.5 cm from the right;
- The title of the paper is to be written on top in capital letters and followed, after some space, by the author's surname, first name, institution (university or other) and position written in full as well as the contact phone number, and the text of the paper to be given after an interval;
- The literature used in the preparation of the paper is to be given in the form of a link (footnote) under each page. The standard bibliographic information for each reference must be provided in full.
- Electronic copies of the papers and abstracts must be submitted to the organizing committee of the conference. The abstracts will be released in the form of an electronic collection. Papers and abstracts can be sent by telegram to @kemranbey (+998 93 545-84-44).
